Step 1: Crocheting the Body

- 1. Make a magic ring and work 6 single crochet (sc) stitches into the ring. Pull the ring closed and join with a slip stitch (sl st) to the first sc.
- 2. Round 2: 2 sc in each st around (12 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 3. Round 3: *Sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around (18 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 4. Rounds 4-6: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 5. Rounds 7-8: *Sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 6. Rounds 9-10: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Step 2: Creating the Head

- 1. Make a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring. Pull the ring closed and join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 2. Round 2: 2 sc in each st around (12 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 3. Round 3: *Sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around (18 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.

- 4. Round 4: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 5. Round 5: *Sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 6. Round 6: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 7. Round 7: *Sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 8. Round 8: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Step 3: Attaching the Head to the Body

- 1. Place the head on top of the body and align the openings.
- 2. Using a yarn needle and black yarn, whipstitch the head to the body, going through both layers of crochet.

Step 4: Making the Ears

- 1. Make a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring. Pull the ring closed and join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 2. Round 2: 2 sc in each st around (12 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 3. Round 3: *Sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st* repeat * * around (18 sc). Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 4. Round 4: Sc in each st around. Join with a sl st to the first sc.
- 5. Rounds 5-6: Repeat Round 4.

Step 5: Attaching the Ears

1. Fold the base of each ear in half and sew or glue it to the sides of the head.

Step 6: Creating the Eyes

- 1. Cut out two small circles from black felt for the eyes.
- 2. Glue the black felt circles to the front of the head.

Step 7: Making the Nose

- 1. Cut out a small heart from pink felt for the nose.
- 2. Sew or glue the pink felt heart to the center of the face.

Step 8: Stuffing and Finishing Touches

- 1. Stuff the body and head firmly with polyester fiberfill.
- 2. Sew or glue the opening of the body and head closed.
- 3. Enjoy your adorable Little Panda Amigurumi!






